SELECTING THE SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES THAT GROW OUR CHARACTER & GLORY

Consider the following spiritual disciplines in light of specific sin patterns with which you wrestle and desire to replace with godly character. * Envy/competiveness - desire for others' traits, status, abilities, or situation.	Solitude, self-examination, gratitude	Kindness
* Lethargy & laziness - avoidance of physical or spiritual work	Caring for the body, exercise	Faithfulness
* Lust - inordinate craving for the pleasures of the body.	Attending to desire in God's presence, confession, fasting, rule of life	Love
Gossip/sins of speech	Silence, self-examination, confession, rule of life	Kindness
Anxiety/worry	Prayer, meditation, journaling, scripture reading, study, confession, gratitude	Peace
Discontent	Attending to desire, journaling, fasting, gratitude, confession	Contentment
